#### GREAT SYNAGOGUE OF IASI

lasi, Romania

Great Synagogue (laşi) is the oldest surviving synagogue in Romania, built between 1657 and 1682. It is an Ashkenazi synagogue in mannerist-early Baroque style, with a brick and stone structure and a fresco decorated interior. It was a center of Jewish life and culture in laşi until the Holocaust, when most of the Jews were killed in the laşi pogrom. The synagogue was restored in 1977 and 2015, and is listed on the National Register of Historic Monuments. It still serves as a synagogue and a tourist attraction
