- 4. Testing: Take the certification exams at the end of the training at an accredited test center.



The ICDL certificate will be granted to candidates who successfully pass all 7 ICDL modules. When a candidate successfully passes modules 2, 3, 7 and one other they will receive the ICDL start certificate.
